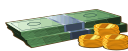

Eucharistic Adoration is the adoration of Jesus Christ Himself, present in the Holy Eucharist. During Adoration, the Eucharist is exposed in a beautiful golden vessel called a monstrance. From the altar, our Lord gazes at us in the Eucharist wanting us to give Him our hearts, burdens, sufferings, joys and sorrows so that He may transform and sanctify us. In the silence of our hearts, we are able to go before Him to love and adore Him simply because He is God. St. Ann's offers **Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every Tuesday from 12:30pm to 8:00pm.** We ask that you consider committing yourself to one hour each Tuesday in Eucharistic Adoration. It will definitely be an hour well spent. **Current times available are 4-5pm and 5-6pm. Also needed are individuals we can add to our sub list to fill in for adorers when they are unable to make their scheduled hour.
