Between these talks, prayer, meditation, and discussion, the Cum Christo weekend offers an opportunity to grow closer to lesus Christ and walk as His disciples. Meditations and talks are presented by lay people and the clergy of our faith. The goal of the Cum Christo weekend is that Christ be the primary influence in our lives and thus our society. The Cum Christo gives those who attend a living understanding of basic Christian truths and the desire to serve Christ and His church. A proven method of living your most authentic Christian life is taught through the Cum Christo. This weekend is much more than a retreat...it is an encounter with Christ!
